Kasse / pay desk

Once you are in the entrance hall of the Uniklinik facing the escalators, the pay desk is to your left on the first floor, i.e. above the Kiosk and the Bank.

Magazin

The „Magazin“ is located on the ground floor, close to the library.

Monday 8:00 – 12:00

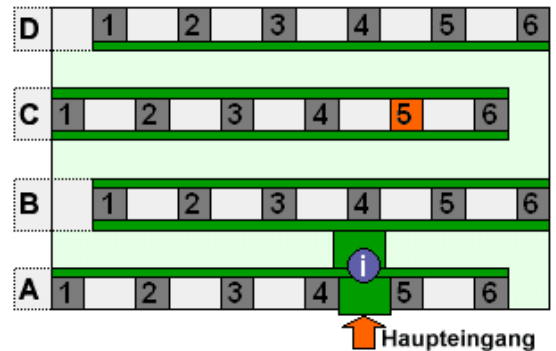

Kleiderausgabe / clothing counter

When you stand in the entrance hall, the clothing counter is on the first floor. Just take the escalators and go straight ahead through a narrow corridor. On your left, there is a yellow door (room 15B) behind which you can get your professional clothes with your electronic student badge from the Magazin.

To pick your size, have a look on the laundry's table.

To return the used clothes, please empty the pockets and put the clothes in the return booth in the wall, on the first floor, corridor B, around the corner of the clothing counter.

Note: you can only return your clothing in this booth!

Please note that you have a limited credit for clothing, so please return **one item at a time**, i.e. first the trousers, then the lab coat. Follow the instructions beside the booth.

For PJ students: The changing room 25 is situated on the first floor, corridor B, room 18.

OP-Umkleide / OR changing room

The OR changing room is slightly difficult to reach, but don't worry, you'll get there!

From the entrance hall, take elevator A4 which is to the left of the Bank and get out on the second floor. There, go to elevator A2 and take it straight down to level -1. Then follow the sign that says "OP-Umkleide".
