

**Fact Sheet**  
for members of staff  
(hospitation / clerkship)  
in clinical care / patient & blood contact

**Hochschulärztliche Einrichtung**  
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Prior to initiation of work at the RWTH Aachen University Hospital, a visit to the University Medical Officer is mandatory.

Besides a physical examination, the following laboratory parameters will be collected:

- blood count
- ESR
- ALT,  $\gamma$ -GT
- blood sugar
- urine status
- anti-HBs
- anti-HBc
- anti-HCV
- anti-HIV (optional)
- cutaneous tuberculosis test (or quantiferon-tb-test / pulmonary X-ray)
- varicella IgG
- (measles IgG)

**Important:**

Proof of Hepatitis B basic immunization (a minimum of 3 vaccinations!) or positive antibody blood test and proof of 2 vaccinations against measles required!

It will take roughly 1 week before all results are collected and work can be initiated.

If all required examinations/results are presented at the examination, an advisory opinion is (routinely) issued on the same day. Those examinations may not be older than 3 months.

Please submit your vaccination card.

**Please consider:**

In our institution, a **hepatitis b antibody titer of 100 IE/l** is considered sufficient following the basic vaccination. (please provide proof of vaccination AND the current titer)

Depending on duration and place of work, the proof is mandatory for the uptake of work.

In the case of an insufficient current antibody titer and missing proof of a successful basis vaccination, a re-vaccination **AND** proof of successful vaccination are mandatory. This might postpone the uptake of work by up to 4 weeks.
